

GIROLATA AND CALANQUES OF PIANA

Gulf of Porto is maybe one of the nicest place of Corsica, the island of beauty or Kalliste like the greeks used to call it. Cliffs, mountains, beaches, volcanic rocks and gorges ... there is a lot to see for the hikers. Classified by UNESCO, the Calanques of Piana offer magnificent landscapes with the red cliffs with strange shapes coming from some very old volcanoes. We will also taste the local food in Girolata, a small village on a peninsula surrounded by the sea.



PROGRAM

Corsica ... the island of beauty!

Day 1 Welcome in Ajaccio

We welcome you at the airport and we organize the transfer to the hotel in Porto.

Bus transfer 2 hours from Ajaccio airport

Accomodation : 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

Day 2 Capu Rossu

We transfer to the village of Piana for a visit and a hike towards Capu Rossu and Genoese tower of Thurgiu. The panoramic views on the gulf of Porto and Calanques of Piana are stunning. Night at the hotel.

Walking duration: 3 hours / 8 km, elevation: 200 m **Accomodation**: 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

Bus transfer 20 minutes

Day 3 Calanques of Piana

Beautiful hike among the volcanic red rocks, the porphyry. The hard rock has been sculpted by the wind and sea to create a natural work of art.

Walking duration: 4 hours / 12 km, elevation: 500 m. **Accomodation**: 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

Bus transfer 15 minutes

Day 4 The Scandola Natural Reserve

Boat Transfer to Porto where we embark on a small boat to visit the reserve, which is not accessible by car. The boat will stop us in Girolata, a beautiful fishermen's village. Return by foot with a lovely hike and stunning views.

Walking duration: 3.5 hours / 8 km, elevation: 400 m Accomodation: 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

DIFFICULTY OF THE HIKES

LEVEL 2

Medium, from 10 years old Elevation between 300 to 600 m Walking duration less than 4 hours Altitude less than 2250 m

Backpack less than 6 Kg (20 liters max) Hiking shoes needed Steady ascents max 30 minutes

WEATHER

Best period is from April to October Temperature can vary from 30 to 10 degrees in the same day.

GROUP

Our groups are composed of 6 to 15 persons per guide.

GUIDING

Our guides have a mountaineering state diploma and a Valley of Merveilles diploma, partnership of the Park of Mercantour and are specialists of Corsica. Passionate about the wild life, he will share his knowledge with you, the nature and the stories of the mountains. Since your security is our primary goal he can give you advices on technics and gear. He is constantly in direct link with local rescuers and carries a first aid kit in complement to the personal ones.



Day 5 Aitone Forest

We transfer inland from Porto to the beautiful forest, surrounded by the Aitone Forest and mountains. We will walk 2 hours among the old Laricio pines and chestnut trees, near a beautiful river, natural pools and on a Genoese arched bridge. Return at the hotel in the end of the afternoon.

Walking duration: 4 hours/10 km, elevation: 400 m **Accomodation:** 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

Bus transfer 30 minutes

Day 6 Evisa and the Spelunca gorges

Bus transfer to Evisa: 23 km / 40 minutes

Hiking : From the village of Evisa, we will go down through the Gorges de la Spélunca to reach the village of Ota. Waterfalls and natural baths will make

participants want to dive.

Walking duration: 5.5 hours/35 km, elevation: 100 m

Accomodation: 2-star Hotel in Porto (seaside)

Bus transfer 10 minutes

Day 7 It is only a au-revoir

Transfer to the airport of Ajaccio.

Please note: the order of the 6 hikes can be re-arranged by the guide depending on weather conditions. Cultural visits can replace the hikes in the worst cases.

LUGGAGE:

Limit volumes and weight, luggage will be transported in bus holds and handled several times during the stay. Save your strengths and those of guides and drivers!

Hotels have either a swimming-pool or access to the sea.




FOOD

DID YOU KNOW?

The Natural Reserve of Scandola is both a marine and land-based reserve. It is managed by the Regional Natural Park of Corsica.

It is located on a volcano that collapsed into the sea – a caldeira- thus forming the Scandola Peninsula and its unique landscapes.

The area is not accessible by car, which has a positive impact on the abundant flora and fauna. The red rocks are reflected by turquoise waters, creating an unbelievable natural color palette. Thanks to this natural richness, Scandola has been added to UNESCO's World Heritage list.

Examples of Flora: green oak trees, strawberry trees, heather, arméria, soleirolii, myrtle, Euboria dendroides, and ragworts with daisy-like leaves

Examples of Fauna: Ospreys, seagulls, bald eagles, Cory's shearwaters, and Peregrine falcons.

To preserve this exceptional, wild area, the Scandola Nature Reserve has a number of rules. Fishing, hunting, and bivouac camping are strictly prohibited.
