Level 1: Easy, from 6 years old. Elevation: from 100 to 250 m; Walking time <3 hours; Altitude <2250 m; Portage <3 Kg (backpack of 20 liters max); All types of sports shoes. Easy trails and regular 15 minute hikes.

Level 2: Moderate, from 9 years old. Elevation: from 250 to 500 m; Walking time <4 hours; Altitude <2250 m; Carrying <3 Kg (backpack of 20 liters max); Recommended hiking shoes. Marked trails and regular 30-minute climbs

Level 3: Moderate sportsman, from 12 years Elevation: from 500 to 750 m; Walking time <5h00; Altitude <3000 m; Carrying <5 Kg (backpack of 30 liters max); Obligatory hiking shoes. Mountain trails marked or not and regular climbs of 30 to 60 minutes

Level 4: Sporty. Elevation from 750 to 1000 m; Walking time <6h00; Altitude > 3000 m; Carrying: > 8 Kg (backpack of 50 liters max); Obligatory hiking shoes. Passage off trails, scree and regular climbs of more than an hour

Level 5: Difficult Elevation > 1000 m; Walking time > 6:00 am; Altitude > 3000 m; Portage: > 10 Kg (backpack of 60 liters and +); Obligatory hiking shoes. All types of terrain, regular climbs of 2 hours and more.

Day 1: Welcome in Menton

We welcome you in the early afternoon at the hotel, 150m from the train station and 200m from the beach. Let's go for a first little walk "City trek of Menton" and welcoming drink with a sea view!

Day 2: On the traces of the Romans

The perched village of Eze is located at the foot of the departmental natural park of the Grande Corniche, its trails, full of history, give a good idea of the diversity of the Mediterranean vegetation. Discovery (full-day; elevation gain 550m; duration 4 hours) Sport (full-day; 750m; 5 hours)

Day 3: Port of the Duchy of Savoy

The natural beauty of the bay of Villefranche-sur-mer has been discovered a long time ago but the Duchy of Savoy selected this place for its quiet water and the protection of the Alps. Discovery (100m; duration 4 hours) Sport (150m; 5 hours)

Day 4: Feet in the Water! (half-day hike)

The Riviera is a place of huge contrast and change of scene. Along the trail, luxurious villas and concrete leave suddenly place to the most exotic vegetation. Discovery (80m; 3 hours) Free afternoon, maybe time to visit Cocteau museum and Carnolès palace in Menton

Day 5: From the Alps to the sea

Perched on a cliff overlooking Menton, Sainte-Agnès is the highest coastal village in Europe. Surely it is a strategic place but from there it is also possible to walk down to the sea. Discovery (elevation gain 150m - elevation loss 700m; duration 5 hours) Sport (500m; 6 hours)

Day 6: Panorama on the Riviera

Roca Bruna village The botanic garden of the summits offer a 360° aerial panorama on the sea and Corsica in certain conditions. Here again, the place is full of stories and history. Choose from: Discovery (400m; duration 3.30 hours) Sport (750m; 5 hours)

Day 7: "it's only a au-revoir"

Breakfast at the hotel and last walk in the narrow streets of Menton for a bit of shopping or visit. Departure from the hotel at 10am and end of the trip.



Between Nice and Menton at the Italian border, the final and southernmost Alps plunge dramatically into the sea. Imposing mountains and limestone cliffs surround the coast but delightful trails go from the summits to the deep blue water. On the coast or on the balconies connecting the perched villages, wild herbs send bewitching scents ...

Day 1 : Welcome drink in Menton

We welcome you in the early afternoon at the hotel, 150m from the train station and 200m from the beach. Let's go for a first little walk "City trek of Menton" and welcoming drink in the evening with a sea view! Night in a 2 star hotel and sea view restaurant in Menton

Day 2 : Panorama of the Mediterranean

The botanic garden of the summits offer a 360° aerial panorama on the sea and Corsica in certain conditions. Here again, the place is full of stories and history... Night in a 2 star hotel and sea view restaurant in Menton Choose from : □ Discovery (elevation gain 400m; walking duration 3.30 hours) □ Sport (elevation gain 700m; walking duration 5 hours)

Day 3 : On the border !

From the village of Castellar, an ancient Roman place, ascent between limestone cliffs and abandoned terraces until the crest between France and Italy is finally reached. Night in a 2 star hotel and sea view restaurant in Menton □ Discovery (elevation gain 400m; walking duration 4 hours) □ Sport (elevation gain 700m; walking duration 5 hours)

Day 4 : A belvedere on the sea

The Sainte-Agnès village, nested in its rocky cliff, is the perfect starting point to reach the summits around. They are the first mountains of the Alps, turn around and you see the Maures and Esterel on one side, Monte Rosa on another one and maybe Corsica. Night in a mountain hotel and sea view restaurant in Sainte-Agnès village, and luggage transfer. □ Discovery (450 m - 4 hours) □ Sport (750 m - 5 hours)

Day 5 : Balconies of the « Mentonnais »

The village of Sainte Agnès will be the start of a historic journey through the perched villages of Gorbio and Roquebrune Cap Martin, we will reach the palaces and castles of the Middle Ages which are the first buildings of these medieval villages with magnificent views of the sea. sea and we will join the beaches of Menton. Night in a 2- star hotel and restaurant overlooking the sea in Menton □ Discovery (550 m - 4 hours) □ Sport (750 m - 5 hours)

Day 6 : From the Alps to the sea

Castillon opens the doors of the Mentonnais high-country and the summits exceeding 1,300 m of altitude (to 10 km of the littoral!). From these peaks, the view takes you to Corsica and the Ligurian Riviera. Night in a 2 star hotel and sea view restaurant in Menton □ Discovery (550 m - 4 hours) □ Sport (750 m - 5 hours)

Day 7 : « It's only an a see you soon... »

Breakfast at the hotel and last walk in the old streets of Menton for a bit of shopping. Departure from the hotel at 10am and end of the trip

Menton area, between Monaco and Italy, is surrounded by imposing summits exceeding 1300m of altitude. Here is the place where Alps plunge into the Mediterranean sea. On the trails along the coast or on the balconies linking the perched villages, you will enjoy the contrast between the limestone cliffs and the blue deep blue water while smelling bewitching scents of the local plants..

Day 1: Welcome in the afternoon

Transfer from Nice airport to your accommodation and check-in. The beach is 50 meters from your room, in the middle of the Pinede and its sandy beaches.

Day 2: Welcome to the Giens Peninsula

After a rich and varied buffet breakfast, we walk on the coastal path of the peninsula with the view towards the «iles d'Hyères » : Porquerolles, Port-Cros and Levant. The coast is very rocky but some creeks and sandy beaches are perfect for a short break or picnic. (Altitude difference: 200 m - Walking time: 5h00) (No transfer)

Day 3: Peninsula and Cap Sicié

It is the highest cliff of the Var, 331m high, which from the chapel ND du Mai, will allow us to enjoy a panorama of the iles d'Hyeres, Giens, the string of islands that Cassis to Marseille, Cape Canaille and Sainte Baume. At our feet: The port of Toulon and many secret beaches ... (Elevation: 450 m - Walking time: 4h30) (Bus transfer 45 minutes)

Day 4: Porquerolles and the tip of Langoustier

After a short walk we reach our little boat for a 25-minute boat trip to the island of Porquerolles, part of the National Park. Our hike will take us to the Silver beach and to the Langoustier, we will tell you the history as well as the stories, and the splendours of the flora. (Elevation: 200 m - Walking time: 4h30)(No transfer)

Day 5: Port Cros Island

Port-Cros is the heart of the first maritime national park in France, at 45 minutes of boat. The island proposes a large variety of trails and many fortresses. We discover the fauna and the endemic flora of this little island, preserved by artists and writers decades ago. (Elevation: 300 m - Walking time: 5h30) (Bus transfer 15 minutes)

Day 6: Cap Lardier and Cap Taillat

From the sandy beach of Figaro, we walk along the sea and then we reach the Cape Lardier with a panoramic view on this wild and preserved coast a few kilometers away from Saint Tropez. A few more kilometers and we reach another peninsula, Cape Taillat. (Elevation: 350 m - Walking time: 5h30) (Bus transfer 25 minutes)

Day 7: Esterel and Cap Roux

Complete change of scene in the Esterel ! We will walk on the footath of Gaspard the "smuggler". Around us the rock is red, it comes from some very old volcanoes, 250 million years ago. In option we can visit the grotta of Saint Honorat, between history and legend... (Elevation: 500 m - Walking time: 5 hours) (Bus transfer 60 minutes)

Day 8: it's only a « au-revoir »

Breakfast at the hotel and last swim at the beach of the hotel, or shopping in Hyères. Departure from the hotel at 10:00 am and end of stay. Option : mini-cruise around the islands.

The geology, landscapes and flora are very diversified in the Riviera between Cannes. The contrast is huge between the red cliffs, the blue water and the mediterranean vegetation that brings colors and scents ... But it is also the sandy beaches and creeks along the coast and of course, the many islands and capes.

Day 1 « Welcome to La Ciotat »

Pick up at the Ciotat train station.

The arrival will be in the afternoon at the hotel in the charming port of La Ciotat. After the briefing on the trip, we will visit LA Ciotat, its port and the Muret park above the sea and surprising rocks. Duration 2 hours.

Day 2 « From Cassis to calanque d'en Vau »

From Cassis, we will go to the Eastern entrance of the brand new national park of the Calanques. From there, we will discover several wonderful calanques : Port Miou, Port Pin and En-Vau. These three beautiful narrow and deep calanques are the easiest to access.

Walking duration: 4 hours

Day 3 At the heart of the calanques 'Sormiou, Morgiou and Sugiton

After breakfast, we will go to Luminy using the Gineste pass thanks to a private transfert. The hike starts at the university campus and brings us to the Morgiou and Sormiou calanques and ends at the most intimate one : Sugiton.

Walking duration: 5 hours

Day 4 : Traversée La Ciotat - Cassis et le Cap Canaille

After breakfast, we will enjoy a 2-hour boat trip to admire all of the calanques from La Ciotat up to Morgiou. Back in La Ciotat, we will leave for a hike around the heights of Cap Canaille, the European highest maritime cliff, offering panoramic views on the area.

Day 5 : La Sainte Baume

After Breakfast, we head to Plan d'Aups. The hike is a 6-hour loop that will allow us to discover the beautiful Sainte Baume massif on the footpaths of Doctor Joseph Pourcel. This passionate man spent more than fifty years to draw and paint the flora of this place.

Walking duration: 5-6 hours

Day 6 : Le sentier des 13 contours

This day will be dedicated to a 4 to 5 hours hike to discover the coastline and calanques massif. We will walk up and around the summit of the Calanques, Mount Puget (565m high) where we will have a unique panorama of all the massif and Marseille city.

Day 7 : Sainte Victoire

After check out, a private transfer will bring us to Saint Antonin-sur-Bavon at the bottom of the mountain Sainte Victoire. The hike will start from this point up until the Croix de Provence where a 360° view on Pagnol and Giono's Provence awaits us. The journey will end at the parking lot around 5.30 pm. Drop off at the La Ciotat train station

The Provence, all around Marseille, holds uncommon natural mountain range. The simple fact to mention « Les calanques » lets us guess the incomparable spectacle of limestone's whiteness reflected in the Mediterranean blue. As well as « La Sainte Victoire ou la Sainte Baume »

legendary mountain ranges where a lot of artists lived, fascinated by the beauty of the scenery. Let's discover Port-Miou, Port Pin, En Vau, Sugiton, Sormiou, Morgiou, Devenson and Figuerolles.

Day 1 Welcome to Grasse

The arrival will be in the afternoon in Grasse in your accommodation. After your installation, we will have a briefing on the trip followed by a drink.

Day 2 City Trek of Grasse

Tour of Grasse and its beautiful quarters: we will use many stairs and hidden narrow streets to discover this very ancient city. The views are magnificent and we will discuss about the stories and the history of Alice de Rothschild, Queen Victoria and Napoleon.

The walk ends up in the city center with a visit of a perfumery.

Elevation 600 meters, walking duration: 5.5 hours

Day 3 The "real" Napoleon road

Starting from the nice village of Saint-Vallier, we will walk on the "real" Napoleon road, a famous page of the French history, which would put an end to the Royalty.

Elevation 580 meters, walking duration: 6 hours

Day 4 Free time or Hike in Esterel

You can spend your day on the Côte d'Azur (Monaco, Antibes, Cannes, Îles de Lérins) or we can organize a cultural visit (village, museum, ...), tourism (Valbonne, Tourrettes-sur-loup, ...) or a completely different hike in the middle of the red rocks of the volcanoes in the Esterel, a balcony above the sea. Swimming at your hotel.

Day 5 The Plateau of Caussols and its bories

We will walk in a typical landscape of this karstic area, full of geological and archaeological sites, inhabited since Neolithic, 6000 years ago. When the sun warms up the cliffs, the big vultures take off and look for food... a superb spectacle for us!

Elevation 600 meters, walking duration: 6 hours

Day 6 Gourdon and the Plateau of Cavillone

Gourdon is one of the most beautiful villages in France. Overlooking the Côte d'Azur, it is known as "the nest of the eagle". During the cold season, the flocks of sheep spend their days in the grassy fields, well protected by the Patous and the shepherds. In this region, the return of the wolf in the 90's is quite an issue!

Elevation 500 meters, walking duration: 6 hours

Day 7 It's only a au-revoir...

After a last breakfast on the terrace, it is time to make the last pictures and say good-bye. We are quite sure you will love the authenticity of this trip.

Discover Grasse, the world's perfume capital, its history and its particular landscapes. Located 15 kms at the North of Cannes, its atmosphere is very different from the Côte d'Azur. This trip uncovers the charms of the Regional Natural Park of the Prealps d'Azur, a mix of wild fauna, ancient villages and panoramic views towards the Mediterranean Sea

Day 01 Welcome in the "Hameau de la Minière"

From the "Lac des Mesches", the entry door of the vallée des Merveilles, a trail in the forest will bring us to the hameau de la Minière, a renowned mining village that will be our base camp for the entire trip. 2-hour hike introducing the local flowers and the landscapes designed by the ice of the glaciers.

Duration of effective walking: 2 hours Elevation gain: 75 m. Elevation loss: 0 m

Day 02 The Vale of Hell and its protohistoric shelters

Starting towards the refuge des Merveilles, by going up in the Vale of la Miniere, among lakes and marmots. In the afternoon we visit the first petroglyphs. Dinner and night at the refuge des Merveilles at 2130m of altitude.

Duration of effective walking: 5h00 Elevation gain: 650 m mandatory.
Elevation : 650 m loss: 0 m.

Day 03 Visit of the valley of Marvels

A complete visit of the site of the Marvels on the archaeological zone called l' Arpette. Discovery of the most famous petroglyphs (Chef de tribu, le sorcier, l'homme aux bras en zigzag etc...). During the afternoon, descent to the hameau de la Miniere.

Duration of effective walking: 6h30 (only 1 backpack for 2 persons for the morning)
Elevation gain: 400 m mandatory. Elevation loss: 650 m.

Day 04 Plan Tendasque, the wild plateau

Off the tracks, we will reach an hidden plateau above the valley, well known from the shepherds. From there, in the larches and orchids lives a rich fauna : chamois, ibex, marmots, eagles ... and maybe some traces of the wolves ?

Duration of effective walking: 4 h Elevation gain: 550 m.

Day 05 The Sacred Path and the Tree of Life

These two famous sites of petroglyphs are part of another vally, the Fontanalba valley. The landscape changes and the rock carvings typology change as well. We'll walk back to the gîte by using the Shepherds' trail. A magical day.

Duration of effective walking: 6h
Elevation gain: 500 m mandatory. Elevation loss: 800 m

Day 06 The village of Tende and the Museum of Marvels

After a short transfer to Tende (30 minutes), we will visit the very interesting Museum of Marvels, with its tools, weapons, potries and other remainings of the protohistoric human beings. Duration of the visit : 2 hours

Only 30 kilometers from the sea and the French Riviera but the contrast is huge ! 6 days visiting this astonishing area, protected as an historical monument since 1989, part of Mercantour National Park. Wildflowers, fauna and 40 000 ancient rock carvings with their myths and legends are waiting for you

6 DAYS and 5 NIGHTS

Day 1 : Welcome to Liguria

We organize your transfer to Levanto.

The afternoon is spent visiting the old town, the seaside, the shops, the rich history of this charming city.

Difficulty : walking time 2 hours and 30 minutes

Welcome drink with wine tasting and briefing on the trip during the evening.

Day 2 : Monterosso and the Giant

Departure by foot from the hotel. We will walk in the shade of the oaks with stunning views on the seaside to reach the crest « Punta di Mesco ». From there we have a panoramic view on the entire Cinque Terre. After the descent, we reach Monterosso, main village of the Cinque Terre, positioned in the center of a natural gulf and famous for its wide and white sandy beach. We will spend time visiting the old town, churches and fortresses.

Difficulty : walking time 6 hours, elevation gain 500 m

Day 3 : The Cinque Terre Traverse

We cross the National Park through the vineyards and coastal paths.

The hike starts in the fishermen village of Riomaggiore, place of the famous Via del Amore, and we will reach the little village of Corniglia, located on a crest and dominating the sea.

It will be retained on the deposit paid and you will be invoiced for any additional costs. In some cases, these costs may be covered by your cancellation insurance. We invite you to be attentive to your insurance contracts.

To avoid these cancellation costs, we strongly recommend that you take out cancellation insurance.

SAS ORGAYA reserves the right to cancel a departure due to an insufficient number of participants, which will occur no later than 21 days before the departure date. Participants will be reimbursed in full for the sums paid, but may in no case claim any compensation other than the reimbursement of these sums. However, if all the participants agree, the trip can be maintained at an additional price calculated as accurately as possible. You will be informed at least 21 days before departure. Any trip interrupted or shortened by a participant, for whatever reason, does not give rise to any refund. Adverse weather conditions are not a valid reason for cancellation. Other causes of cancellation, linked to a local risk situation (political, health, climatic conditions, natural disaster ...), can occur at any time. In all these cases, the participants registered are fully reimbursed, but cannot claim any compensation.

Trip interruption: Any voluntary interruption on your part does not give rise to any refund. This is also valid in case of an exclusion decided by your guide (see Responsibility section).

In case of cancellation on our part, participants will be notified at the latest 15 days before departure. They will be fully reimbursed without being able to claim compensation.

Responsibilities:

Formalities: The information given on our technical sheets concerning police, customs and vaccine formalities must be checked, as well as the connections (rail, air, etc.) which are given for information only, and cannot engage our responsibility. It is notably the responsibility of each participant to ensure before departure that they are in order with the police, customs and health formalities (passport, visa, vaccination certificate, recommended vaccines), and to comply with these formalities during travel.

Risks: Any physical activity or trip involves a risk, however small it may be. Each participant is aware of this and assumes it with full knowledge of the facts, and undertakes not to hold responsible for any accidents that may occur, SAS ORGAYA, accompanying persons or various service providers. This also applies to beneficiaries and any member of the family. Each participant must comply with the rules of caution and safety given by the guide. SAS ORGAYA cannot be held responsible for accidents which would be due to the imprudence of a member of the group and reserves the right to exclude from the stay, at any time, a person whose behavior can be considered as compromising safety or the well-being of the group. As such, the guide remains the sole judge on the ground. No compensation would then be due.

BAGGAGE

They remain permanently under your responsibility. Your luggage can be transported by rudimentary means (back of mules, roof rack on vehicles), they can undergo damage. We will in no case be able to investigate complaints on this subject. However, out of professionalism, we implement the means necessary to best protect your luggage. Follow the advice of Mountain Guides in choosing the quality of your luggage. Your luggage must respect the weight of 20 kg maximum (weight of luggage to be confirmed by the airlines).

Keep your valuables with you.

HEALTH

For certain stays, you will be asked for a medical certificate indicating that you are not contraindicated to hiking. This particular request will be notified in the technical sheet.

INSURANCE

Each participant must have individual liability insurance. At registration we offer additional travel insurance. This insurance represents a percentage of the price of the stay (on request). It covers the reimbursement of the cancellation costs retained by us, in the cases and under the conditions appearing on the contract.

It also covers the costs of assistance and repatriation. You must be insured for this risk. If you do not subscribe to this insurance, we will ask you for a copy of your contract, with the coverages included and the assistance call number. A copy of the insurance contract will be attached to the registration confirmation.

PRICES

Unless otherwise indicated in the technical sheet, they include from the meeting point to the dispersing point: the costs of organization, supervision and training, transport, accommodation and food. They do not include insurance, personal expenses (drinks, tips, etc.) and transportation to the meeting point.

Family and group conditions: The minimum registration age is mentioned on the technical sheet. 15% reduction for children under 12, 10% for 12 to 16 years old. Beyond 16 years the price is considered as for adults.

ROUTES

Depending on the weather, snow conditions, level of participants or unforeseen events, and in particular if security requires, we reserve the right to modify the program or the itinerary without the participants being able to claim to indemnity.

SECURITY

Each participant must comply with the rules of caution and safety given by the guide. The latter reserves the right to exclude at any time a person whose behavior could be considered to compromise the safety and well-being of the rest of the group.

DISPUTES

Any dispute resulting from the above conditions is the responsibility of the Commercial Court of Nice. (France)

PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA :

The general data protection regulation (GDPR), which applies from May 25, 2018, aims to allow everyone to control the use of their personal data. We do not transmit personal data and do not distribute name lists on the Internet or any other medium of global transmission (social networks in particular). The collection and transfer of this information is necessary for the performance of the services. In accordance with the data-processing law and freedoms of January 6, 1978, the Customer has a right of access, rectification and deletion of the personal data concerning him on simple written request.
