Whatever the delay between cancellation and the scheduled departure date, the price of the plane ticket is due. It will be retained on the deposit paid and you will be invoiced for any additional costs. In some cases, these costs may be covered by your cancellation insurance. We invite you to be attentive to your insurance contract. In order to avoid these cancellation costs, we strongly recommend that you subscribe to a cancellation insurance.

SAS ORGAYA reserves the right to cancel a departure due to an insufficient number of participants, which will occur no later than 21 days before the departure date. The participants will be reimbursed in full for the sums paid, but may in no case claim any compensation other than the reimbursement of these sums. However, if all the participants agree, the trip can be maintained at an additional cost, calculated as accurately as possible. You will be informed at least 21 days before departure. Any trip interrupted or shortened by a participant, for whatever reason, does not give rise to any refund. Adverse weather conditions are not a valid reason for cancellation. Other causes of cancellation, linked to a local risk situation (political, health, climat conditions, natural disaster...) can occur at any time. In all these cases, the participants enroled are fully reimbursed, but cannot claim any compensation.

#### RESPONSABILITIES

- Formalities: The information provided on our technical sheets concerning police, customs and vaccins must be checked as well as the connections (flights, trains etc) which are given for information only, and cannot engage our responsibility. It is notably the responsability of each participant to ensure before departure that they are in order with the police, customs and health formalities (passport, visa, vaccination certificate, recommended vaccins), and to comply with these formalities during the trip.
- <u>Risks</u>: Any physical activity or trip involves a risk, however small it may be. Each participant is aware of this and assumes it with full knowledge of the facts, and undertakes not to hold responsible for any accidents that may occur, SAS ORGAYA, accompanying persons or various service providers. This also applies to beneficiaries and any members of the family. Each participant must comply with the rules of caution and safety given by the guide. SAS ORGAYA cannot be held responsible for accidents which would be due to the imprudence of a member of the group and reserves the right to exclude from the stay, at any time, a person whose behaviour can be considered as compromising safety or the well-being of the group. As such, the guide remains the sole judge on the ground. No compensation would then be due.

#### LUGGAGE

It remains at all times under your responsibility. Your luggage can be transported by rudimentary means (back of mules, roof rack on vehicules), and can undergo damage. We will in no case be able to investigate complaints on this subject. However, out of professionalism, we implement the means necessary to best protect your luggage. Follow the advice of the Mountain guides in choosing the quality of your luggage. Your luggage must respect the weight of 20 kg maximum (weight of luggage to be confirmed according to the airline). Keep your valuables with you.

#### **HEALTH**

For certain stays, you will be asked for a medical certificate stating that you are not counter-indicated to hiking. This particular request will be notified on the technical sheet.

INSURANCE

Each participant must have individual liability insurance. At registration we offer additional travel insurance. The insurance represents a percentage of the price of the stay (on request). It covers the reimbursement of the cancellation fees retained by us, in the cases and under the conditions appearing in the contract. It also covers the costs of assistance and repatration. You must be insured for this risk. If you do no subscribe to this insurance, we will ask you for a copy of your contract, with the coverages included and the assistance call number. A copy of the insurance contract will be attached to the registration confirmation.

#### PRICES

Unless otherwise stated on the technical sheet, the prices include from the meeting point to the dispersing point: the cost of organisation, supervision and training, transport, accommodation and food. They do not include insurance, personal expenses (drinks, tips etc) and transportation to the meeting point. Family and group conditions: The minimum registration age is mentionned on the technical sheet. 15% reduction for children under 12, 10% for 12 to 14 years old. Above 14 years, the price is considered as for adults.

#### ROUTES

Depending on the weather, snow conditions, level of participants, or unforseen events, and in particularly if security requires, we reserve the right to modify the program or the itinerary without the participants being able to claim any compensation.

#### SECURITY

Each participant must comply with the rules of caution and safety given by the guide. The latter reserves the right to exclude at any time a person whose behaviour could be considered to compromise the safety and wellbeing of the rest of the group.

#### DISPUTES
